DISTANCE LEARNING EXPECTATIONS



WEEKLY SCHEDULE

Students will have each subject twice a week:

Monday/Wednesday - English and History

Tuesday/Thursday - Math and Science

Friday will not have "class" but will use that time to take weekly Assessments.

Advisory will be used for check ins with students. They will be given a specific day for their Advisory class.



DAILY SCHEDULES

Students will be required to submit attendance EVERY morning from 9:00-9:30. Classes will begin at 9:30.

Each class with start with the students watching a pre-recorded video from their teacher. This video will introduce the lesson, teach any skills, and tell them their instructions for their assignment.

Each class will have a Daily Assignment that will be due at 3:20 everyday.

- Example Mondays they will have an English and History assignment due at 3:20 each day.
- These assignments will not be long and can be completed in less than one hour.



What If Students Need Help?

Teachers will be holding live "Office Hours" everyday from 12:40-2:00.

During this time students can chat with, or video chat, with their teacher and get help or clarity in real time.

Teachers will also be available by email during normal school hours.

Students may always contact them at any time. The "Office Hours" are there to provide an opportunity for immediate feedback from their teachers.



How can I help my student stay on track?

I will be providing them will a quick reference of what their week will look like at the beginning of every week. It will have their schedule, important links, and what assignments they will be completing/when they are due. I will post it on the homepage of my weebly. It will look something like this:

How Will Work be Assigned?

All work will be accessed through Google Classroom.

Students have a separate classroom website for EACH subject. The codes are listed on my weebly, and I will put them at the end of this presentation as well.

In the next few slides I will list the types of work they will be completing in each subject.

Some assignments may require them to work on paper and take a photo of their work to upload to the classroom. I will go over how to do that when/if it becomes necessary.



English & History

English:

Students will be using CommonLit for their English work. All assignments will be accessed through Google Classroom.

They will be reading articles, making annotations, and answering questions using evidence from the text. Each week will have a different focus when reading and understanding the texts.

History:

Students will be completing two types of tasks:

- 1. Our students our currently living through history. Each week they will be writing in a digital journal. They will be sharing their experiences through this quarantine.
- 2. They will be working on assignments to continue their historical learning.



Math & Science

Math:

Most assignments will be created through Khan Academy online, along with some supplemental practice from me. Alway check Google Classroom for Assignments

We will begin by focusing on basic skill building and reteaching concepts before moving on to new things.

Science:

Science will continue as it has been through Amplify Science.

I will share the assignments on Google Classroom for students to complete.



What if we cannot make the schedule work?

In a perfect world students would be able to stick to our prepared schedule, but we know life is going on in your houses, and some of you have multiple children and family members you are caring for and that's okay!

- Students <u>MUST</u> submit attendance in the morning as scheduled.
- Class materials can be accessed anytime throughout the day.
 Students can work at their own pace as long as they are submitting their <u>Daily Assignments by 3:20.</u>
